ACADEMIC SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION & GENERAL INFORMATION

The Kendall Park Learning Center Summer Academic Session offers advanced/full credit, review credit, and preview/enrichment opportunities for your child. You may choose from a variety of courses. Students may be required to take a placement test to ensure that instruction is given on the appropriate level. Parents are encouraged to bring in reports and recommendations from the student's teacher or guidance counselor.

Our certified, experienced, and dedicated teachers help students gain confidence in their scholastic abilities and guide students to a new appreciation of their talents. Teachers provide instruction in small groups to make sure that personal attention is given to each and every student. Mid-session and final reports are sent home keeping families apprised of student progress.

Mail-in registration must be post-marked by Tuesday, June 5th. After that day, registration must be done in person at the Kendall Park Learning Center. Registrations accepted after June 20th will require a \$25 late fee.

Refunds and Cancellations:

- The tuition, minus \$250, is refundable if a student withdraws on or before June 1st.
- If student withdraws on or before June 15th, 50% of tuition will be refunded.
- If student withdraws after June 15th, 0% of tuition will be refunded.
- If the course is cancelled, the course tuition will be refunded in full.
- Refunds take approximately five weeks to process.
- There will be no refunds for missed days or holidays.
- *Students, who withdraw from the courses early, either because the class is too easy or too difficult will not have their tuition refunded. Students whose behavior is unsuitable for a classroom environment (either distracting or detrimental to the class and fellow students) will be asked to leave without any refund of tuition.*

Course Credit

Under all circumstances in which the student intends to transfer credit to another school, advance agreement must be obtained from either the school principal or guidance counselor that successful completion of the KPLC coursework will satisfy credit transfer requirements. A copy of this agreement should be given to the KPLC Summer Program office before registration.

General Information

• *Class Dates:*

All classes begin Thursday, June 28 except for those listed below

- *Honors Biology with Lab classes begin Tuesday, June 26*
- *Honors Chemistry with Lab classes begin Tuesday, June 26*
- *Honors Physics with Lab classes begin Tuesday, June 26*

All classes end Friday, August 3rd except for those listed below

- *All SAT classes end Wednesday, August 1st*

In the past few years, many classes have closed due to over enrollment. We, therefore, encourage you to register as soon as possible to avoid being turned away.

- If you are taking only one 60 hour class, please indicate on your registration form what time slot you prefer. All effort will be made to fulfill your request. If this cannot be done, you will receive a phone call notifying you of the time the class will meet.
- Mid-session reports will be **emailed** to parents on July 19th. Final reports will be mailed on August 17th.
- Report cards will not be mailed to the child's school unless either the guidance counselor or the principal has signed the permission form (see [registration form](#)).
- **Students are not allowed to leave the school premises during break.**
- You can pick up a car-pool list between June 18th – 22nd. **Please inform us if you do not want your name on the list; otherwise it will be included on list.**
- There is no school on Wednesday, July 4th.
